
BalMan, the maneuvering stratospheric balloon

(for CNES - French Space Agency)

Within the framework of "France Relance", HEMERIA develops for the CNES an innovative stratospheric balloon: the maneuvering balloon. This stratospheric balloon is able to pilot its trajectory in the stratosphere.

Benefits:

- A stratospheric balloon able to adjust its trajectory in the stratosphere
- Facilitate access to space at lower cost and environmental impact
- Flying over an area of interest for a longer time
- Reduction of logistical and operational constraints





Envelopes of the Stratobus™ project

(for Thales Alenia Space)

Since 2015, HEMERIA has been working with Thales Alenia Space on the Stratobus[™] program. Stratobus[™] is a stratospheric airship, which is halfway between a drone and a satellite.

HEMERIA is involved in the design and manufacture of the airship's envelopes.

Benefits:

- Long-term flight: up to 1 year in the stratosphere
- Able to stay in stationary position
